If you have any concerns regarding your child and SEND

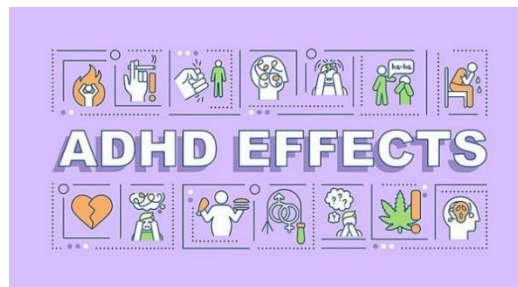

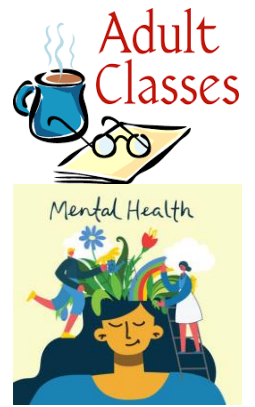
Adult Education Centre Workshops
