

Phonics

We will continue to revise and consolidate the sounds already taught and begin to learn new set 3 sounds and their rhymes. We will practice blending sounds for reading and segmenting words in writing. Children will revise tricky words already learned and be able to spell the common exception words already taught.

Handwriting

We will continue to practice the correct letter formation for each letter. The children will continue to learn the capital letter formation for these letters and use RWI rhymes to support their writing.



SPaG

The children will cover a variety of oral and written tasks to support their knowledge of: Capital letters, adjectives, exclamation marks, question marks and conjunctions.



Science: Plants

We will be Identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

The Children will also look at what plants need to survive. They will plant their own seed whilst nourishing it with sunlight and water. We will observe and make recordings.



Maths

- Naming and recognizing 2D and 3D shapes.
- Counting, comparing and ordering numbers to 20.
- Addition and subtraction within 20.
- Reading and writing numerals in words.(1-20)
- Find simple 'differences' and completing word problems.
- Number bonds to 10.
- Finding doubles and near doubles.
- Place value to 50.
- Partitioning tens and ones.
- Comparing and measuring length, height, mass, capacity and volume.
- Counting in multiples of two, five and ten.

English



This term, the children will continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly. They will join sentences with and or because and use adjectives to improve the standard of our writing. We will focus on a variety of texts such as; Rosa Parks, Manfred the Baddie, The Queen's Hat and My Name is not Refugee.
