We want the children to continue to;

Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly. Join sentences with and or because.

Use adjectives to improve the standard of our writing.

Fiction writing: Jack and the Beanstalk, The Tiger Who Came To Tea, Manfred the Baddie and The Queen's Hat.

We will create our own stories where we can apply all of our knowledge to longer pieces of writing.

We will be looking at information texts about significant figures.



Science:

Plants and Seasons



We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

The Children will also look at what plants need to survive. We will plant our own seed and observe how it grows.

Maths

Count forwards, backwards and write numbers to 20.

Count across to 100, forwards and backwards, beginning from 0 or 1, from any given number. (on-going throughout the year)

Number- addition and subtraction within 20.

Place value- understanding number to 50.

Counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Measurement- length and height.

Measurement- weight and volume.

Please help support your child by recognising numbers and writing them correctly. The children need to continue to write and form numbers ensuring they are the right way around.
