Silent Auction

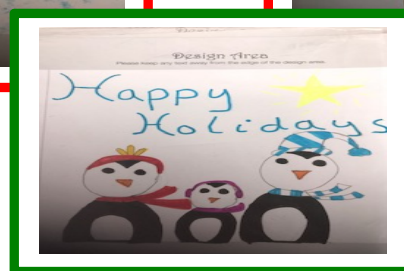
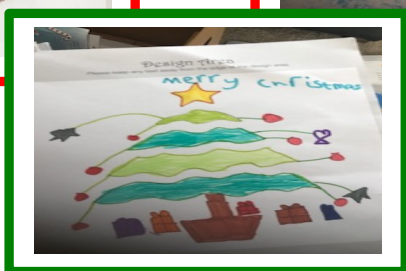
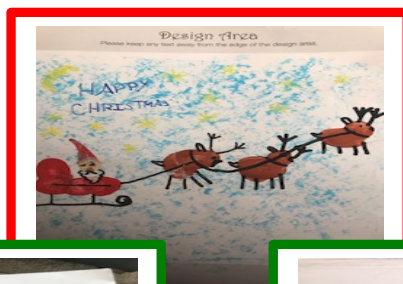
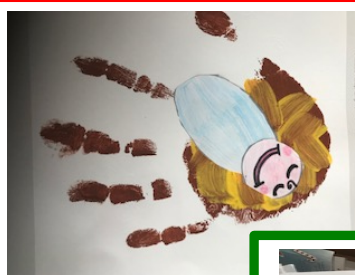
